

Cedar Beach Park Rules

CAMP FIRES - Must be contained in the fire ring provided. Please do not move fire ring.

WOOD - No wood may be brought into the park. All firewood must be purchased from the park.

GARBAGE - Garbage disposal located at the main entrance, no disposal of furniture or appliances. Please recycle.

PETS - Pets must be on a leash and quiet. Please clean up after them and be considerate of others.

QUIET HOURS - 11:00pm to 8:00am. Minimal noise tolerated, no music. All children under the age of 16 on lot after 10:00pm or accompanied by an adult. Music disturbances to others will not be tolerated at any time.

RESPONSIBILITY - Campers are responsible at all times for the safety and conduct of their family and quests.

RIGHTS - Cedar Beach Park Ltd is a privately owned family campground. The park management retains the right to remove any trailer or campers due to lack of cooperation.

TRAILER SALES - All trailer sales must be arranged through the park office and pass both a TSSA and trailer inspection.

PARKING - One car is included in reservation and may be parked on lot. All additional vehicles are subject to charge and must be parked in the parking lot. Receipt must be displayed on dash.

VISITORS - Must register and pay a visitors fee at park office before entering park. Park closes at 9pm.

- Security issues please press the "security" button on the exterior wall office phone or dial the main park number 905-642-1700 and press 8. (Firewood, ice or a shortage of beer are not considered urgent!)
- Emergency (fire, police or ambulance) dial 911. Markham Stouffville Hospital – turn right at park gates onto Ninth Line. South on the Ninth Line to Main Street Stouffville, road jogs, turn right and then immediately left and continue south on Ninth Line
- There is an independently leased restaurant and a variety store on site, for your convenience.
- Recreation equipment available at the office requires a \$20.00 refundable deposit, no charge for their use.
- Boats are available to rent. Lifejackets are available with a deposit of \$50.00. No charge for use.
- Two great conservation areas for hiking and letting the dog run free. See the map for directions #1 & 2.
